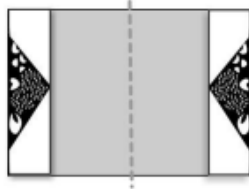

1. Cut out the rectangle. Fold the narrow side rectangles to the back.



2 Fold in half and leave folded.



3 Fold the top down to the bottom and then open back up.



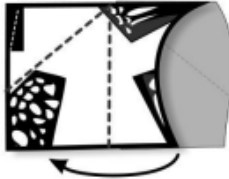
4 Rotate a quarter turn so that the fold is at the top. Fold the top corners into the center line.



5 After folding the corners down, open them back up.



6 Fold the bottom right corner over to the left corner



7 Turn over and Repeat on the other side.



8 Rotate so the point is at the bottom



9 Crease along the indicated lines



10 Fold the wings down



11 Cut the antennae on the back and fold upward.
